To any Lawful Officer for said District, Greeting  
Forasmuch as John E. Norris hath personally  
appeared before me, and duly made oath, that  
his negro Slave Simon Ranaway from his em-  
ploy on or about the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November last-  
past, & remained Ranaway until some time in  
February last past - and that he has good rea-  
sons to believe and verily doth believe that Mary-  
or Maryann a female Slave of O. R. Broyles  
knowing the said Slave Simon to be a Ranaway  
did feloniously harbour said Slave Simon  
by giving him victuals and Spirits - and by  
sleeping and staying with the said Slave Simon  
in a camp in the woods - There are therefore  
to require and comenand you forthwith to  
arrest and bring the said Slave Maryann  
before me or some other Magistrate for said  
District to answer to the said complaint, and



to be further dealt with according to Law  
Union fail not - Given under my hand  
and Seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1843
