To all to whom these Presents shall come be seen or made known, I Lightfoot Harrison Davis of the City of Charleston in the State of South Carolina, <sup>Gentleman</sup> send greeting - Know ye that I the said Lightfoot Harrison Davis for and in Consideration of the sum of ten Shillings Sterling Money of the said State to me in hand & well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, and for divers other good causes and Considerations me thereunto especially moving Have Manumitted, Enfranchis'd, set free and discharged, and by these Presents do fully, freely and absolutely, Manumitt, enfranchise, set free and discharge my Mulatto woman Slave named Hester and her two Mulatto Children named Mary & William (but are now commonly called and known by the names of Polly & Billy) of and from all and all manner of bondage & Slavery whatsoever to have and to hold such Manumission and Freedom unto the said Mulatto woman Slave and her two Mulatto children Mary and William and the future Issue and Increase of the said female Slaves for ever in as full and ample a Manner to all intents constructions & purposes as any other Slaves heretofore set free and discharged from the bond of Slavery, may have hold or enjoy. So that neither I the said Lightfoot Harrison Davis, my Executors, admors or assigns nor any other person or persons for me or in my name or to my or their use shall or may at any time hereafter claim Challenge or demand any manner of Right, Title Claim or demand of in or to the said Mulatto woman Slave named Hester and her two Mulatto Children named Mary & William or either of them or the Issue and Increase of the said female Slaves. In Witness whereof I the said Lightfoot Harrison Davis have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty seventh day of Janu<sup>y</sup> in the year of our Lord one thousand

March, Binder, Judy, Sampson, Peggy, Benny, Charles  
Sam, Watter, Hannah, Sall, and Dilla, together with  
the future issue and increase of the said female Slaves -  
To have and to hold all those the said thirty negro and  
other Slaves together with the future issue & increase  
of the said female Slaves unto the said William Elliott  
Edings for his Exors, admors and assigns to his and their  
only proper use and behoof forever. And I the said George  
Archibald for my self my Heirs Exors and admors do hereby  
Covenant promise, grant and agree to and with the said
