

Marriage records from an old book used by Rev. Mansfield French, Chaplain in U.S. Army, stationed at Beaufort, South Carolina from March 1862 as Chaplain of Hospital Base No. 1, U.S. Army. He was engaged in Freedmen's Bureau work for the Government and held his commission as Chaplain until about February 1868, working in Negro education & relief work at Beaufort and at Charleston, S.C.
